

CINSER Faculty Research and Innovation Grants (FRIG)

Spring 2018

The CINSER Faculty Research and Innovation Grants (FRIG) can be awarded to Unit A, Unit B and adjunct faculty members serving any academic program at Chicago State University to provide funding for critical supplies, research travel, presentations and fees related to open access publishing. Any basic or applied research, project or creative activity related to any germane aspect of safety, security or intelligence from any disciplinary perspective can be supported with this grant. Grant awards will not to exceed \$2,000.

Awards are competitive and evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Relevance of grant activity to current issues in safety, security and/or intelligence with a priority given to projects related to communities on the south side of Chicago and/or in the Chicagoland area
- Potential to impact community, regional, national or international safety and security
- Potential to enhance CSU and CINSER's reputation for academic excellence
- Overall quality of application and proposal
- Quality of proposed budget
